Climbing and Rappelling Tower usage

Usage of the climbing and rappelling tower at Camp Horne is scheduled on a first come serve basis. A camp use permit is required to reserve the tower for the weekend and dates must be checked in advance through the office to ensure a Climbing Director is available. For Scouting units a fee of \$125 is due at the time of reservation. Fees are required in order to have a Climbing Director present and to assist with replacing the equipment. It is recommended that groups of 15 to 20 schedule to use the tower to maximize the facility and the enjoyment for participants. All activities on the tower are under the direction of the Council Climbing Director. If for some reason the tower must be closed for the remainder of the weekend with less than 4 hours of total usage, a pro-rated refund will be issued to the Unit. All fees are due in full from the Scout Unit the last business day before your scheduled usage. All Health History and Hold Harmless Agreements are to be properly filled out with all appropriate signatures and turned into the Climbing Director the day of the event. Only those with properly filled out forms will be allowed to participate, no refunds for insufficient paperwork.

Weekend tower usage is up to 12 hours of safe operation as determined by the Climbing Director between 8:00 am Saturday morning and 12:00 pm on Sunday.

Usage fees are as follows for Scouting units:

\$125 (due at reservation)

1-25 participants -\$5 per person

26+ participants add an additional \$2 per person.

Non-Scout Usage:

\$250 due at reservation

1-25 participants \$10 per person

26+ participants add an additional \$5

Example: Troop 2010 reserves the tower for June 1. They pay the \$125 reservation fee.

The Friday before their scheduled arrival the unit pays the office \$5 per participant for the 23 that they have attending for a total of \$115 that day. Total weekend usage fees for the tower would be \$ 240 for 23 participants.
