

Personal Checklist – What to Bring to Camp

Scouts attending camp will be sleeping in three-sided Adirondacks or wall tents on wooden platforms. Each Adirondack has two bunk beds with foam mattresses to house up to four campers. Each wall tent has two cots for two campers (there are a limited number of wall tents). Due to the extended camping session, Scouts may find it useful to pack in a plastic tote or footlocker to assist with items staying dry and better protected from the elements. Due to the heat and humidity that may occur during a week of summer camp, it is advisable for Scouts pack a change of clothing for each day (extra socks are great!). If you choose to bring any snacks, be sure to pack them in a plastic, air-tight container to protect from bugs and other hungry critters that may be around. Leave expensive items that you wouldn't want to lose or possibly be damaged at home.

Suggested Personal Checklist

- COMPLETE Scouts BSA Uniform
- Scout BSA Handbook
- T-shirts, shorts, socks, underwear, hat, sweater or jacket (at times, it does get cool at night)
- Swim trunks and sunscreen
- Towels (for aquatics and showers), wash rags
- Toiletries (toothpaste, toothbrush, soap, shampoo, etc.)
- Shower shoes
- Rain poncho or jacket
- Extra pair of shoes or boots
- Water bottle
- Watch
- Flashlight with new batteries
- Sleeping bag or sheets and a blanket
- Pillow
- Pocket knife (as unit approves and with Totin' Chip)
- Bug repellent
- Camp chair (if desired)
- MB pamphlets
- Clothesline and clothes pins
- Spending money for trading post
- Health and Medical Form (parts A,B, & C)

Medications: Any medications must be in its original container with proper labeling, including the Scout's name. Epi-pens & inhalers maybe kept on the Scout with leader's & camp Health Officer's knowledge. Medicines requiring medication may be stored in the Health Lodge.

- Compass
- Sunglasses
- Religious book
- OA Sash
- Hammock

What NOT to Bring to Camp

- ✓ Pets
- ✓ Electrical equipment
- ✓ Expensive items
- ✓ Sheath knives
- ✓ Firearms or ammunition

- ✓ Tobacco, alcohol, illegal drugs
- ✓ Vaping paraphernalia
