- 3. Scouting experience is preferred but not required. However, ALL camp staff members must be registered as a "Camp Staff" member during the time of service.
- 4. All employees will be required to complete Employment Eligibility Verification (I-9), W-4, and A-4 forms as required by local, state, or federal law.
- 5. Selected staff must be able to participate in camp staff training sessions and complete BSA required online training videos. Staff training and camping season dates are listed on the summer camp webpage.
