As the United States of America celebrates 250 years since the signing of the Declaration of Independence, the Black Warrior Council presents Scouts a dynamic opportunity to work on requirements for Citizenship in the Community, Nation, and World. Eagle Scouts on the staff and faculty of the University of Alabama have volunteered to teach classes to help our Scouts earn these important Eagle-Required merit badges. Scouts will have the chance to complete most, if not all, of a select Citizenship merit badge.
